

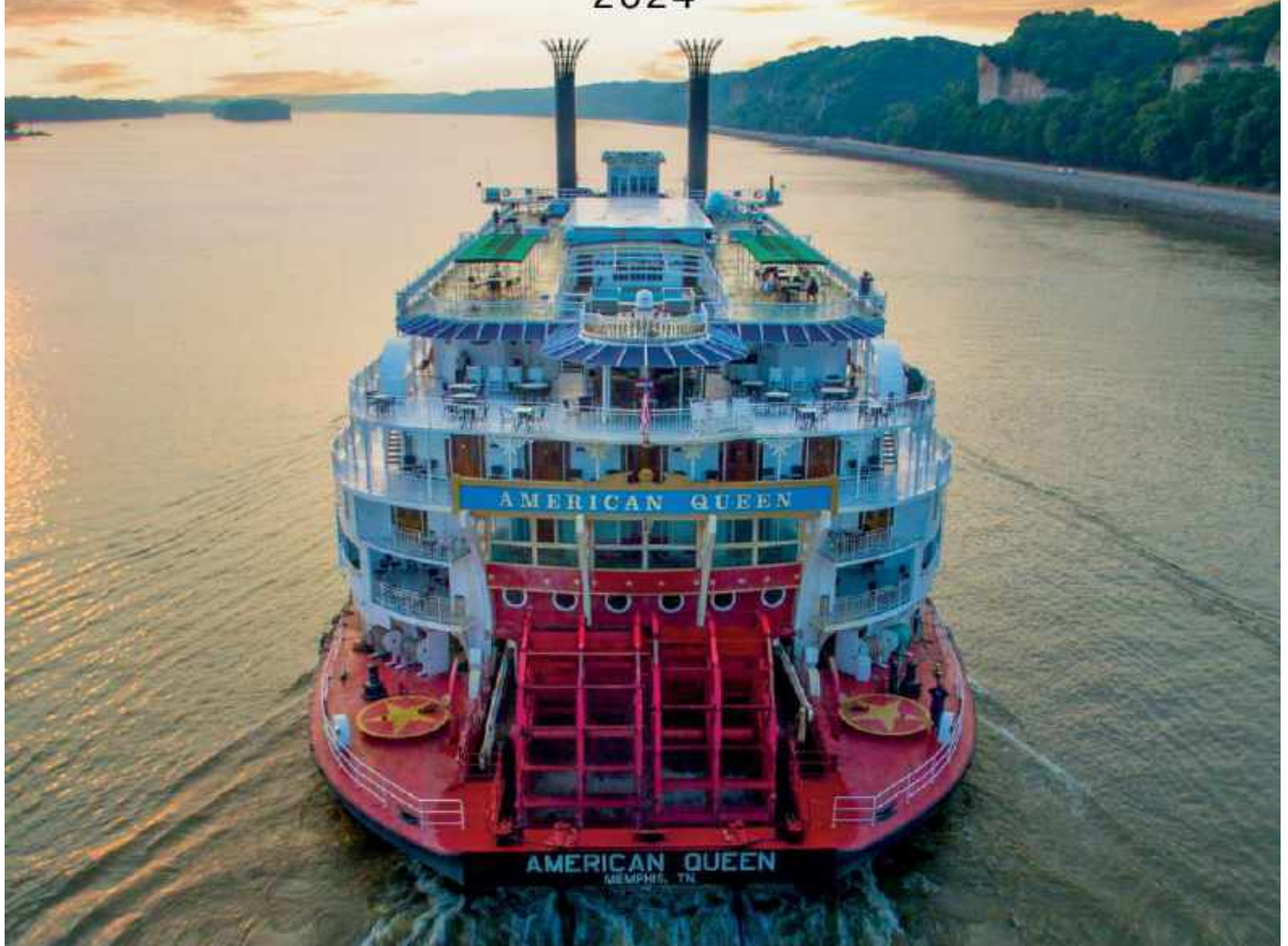

On our voyages, every day offers a fresh adventure. In fact, often several of them.

At any given moment, you may hear the house band playing swing standards and R&B requests, well. Or Mark Twain, beguiling the room with his trademark anecdotes and shaggy dog stories. World-class guest performers, demonstrating what it takes to win Grammys and Tonys. Or local vaquera dancers, showing off moves that would make a conquistador blush.

On top of all that diversion, a wealth of delightful mental stimulation is afoot. Fascinating lore and regional insights about the waterways we visit are being shared in presentations by our Riverlorians — expert river historians unique to American Queen Voyages. Onshore explorations are taking way, enriched with deep cultural understanding by those who lead them. Talks on Alaska's thrilling wildlife are being given nightly on our expedition voyages to that corner of the world, while far to the south, marine biologists are briefing guests on the fauna just sighted during their ocean journey along Mexico's Pacific coast.

WHERE WE SAIL

In the convivial atmosphere of camaraderie aboard a riverboat or expedition ship, discoveries made ashore become connections enjoyed on board as you chat with fellow travelers over the day's adventures. The mood is easy, enriching diversions abound as you find yourself delightfully relaxed while actively engaged and you're savoring the day's pursuits along with newfound friends. Lectures by Riverlorians offer insights that bring the history and local culture of the river communities into sharper focus, while naturalists on our expedition cruises share their knowledge of the ecosystem and wildlife. Discovery runs deep and each day a new adventure awaits.

NAVIGATING LOCKS, CHANNELS & DAMS

Our paddlewheel riverboats safely traverse natural obstructions such as rocks, shallow water, and rolling rapids using a system of locks (or chambers) and dams operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. There is a 9-foot channel and 28 lock and dam structures built along the Upper Mississippi that allows boats to navigate from St. Louis to St. Paul (or vice versa). The Missouri, Illinois, Arkansas, Ohio, and other rivers flow into the Lower Mississippi, making the river wider and deeper downstream. As a result, you won't find locks and dams on lower sections of the Mississippi. All daytime lock transits will be noted on your day-by-day itinerary so you can be out on deck to encounter this engineering marvel first-hand and capture the experience with your phone or camera.

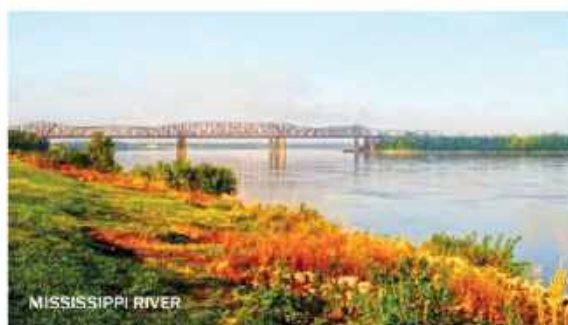

Sacajawea State Park is a 284-acre day-use park operated by the state of Washington and located at the confluence of the Snake and Columbia Rivers where Lewis and Clark arrived on October 16, 1805. An excellent interpretive center and museum features interactive displays that tell the story of the Lewis and Clark expedition through the experiences of Sacajawea, the young Shoshone Indian woman who accompanied the expedition. It is also the site of one of seven "confluence" installations designed by noted artist Maya Lin for the 2005 Lewis and Clark bicentennial.



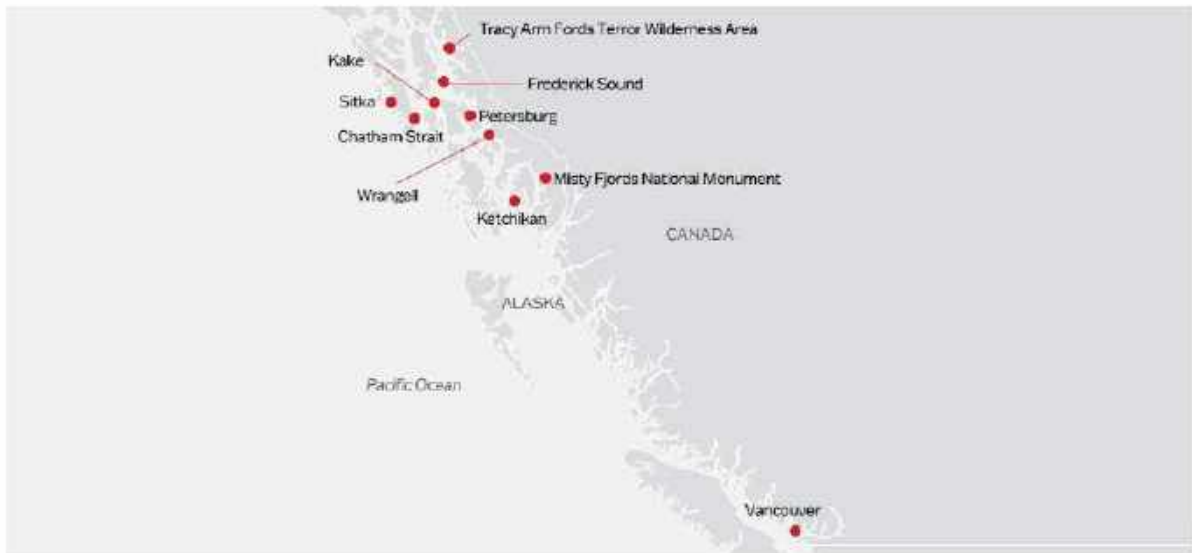
